

Concordia team wins national title

TORONTO - The Concordia University College of Alberta Women's Soccer team are the 2009 Canadian Colleges Athletics Association (CCAA) National Champions! It was a story book ending to a dream season for the Thunder Women's Soccer team as it returned home from the CCAA Women's Soccer National Championships in Toronto as the 2009 CCAA National Champions.

Concordia defeated the OCAA Champion Fanshawe Falcons 2-1 in extra time scoring the go-ahead goal with only minutes to spare. The team advanced to the gold medal game after a 3-2 shoot-out win over the host Humber Hawks and a 2-1 victory over the number 1 seeded Kwantlen Polytechnic University Eagles of the BCCAA.

The National Championship brings to a close the perfect season for the Thunder Women's Soccer



team who finished undefeated on the year with a 13-0-2 overall record for the 2009 season. Lindsay Monkman, Trish Arends, and Kelly Anderson were each named to the 2009 Tournament All-Star team

while Concordia's Alesha Weicker was honoured the Tournament MVP.

This marks the first CCAA National Championship for Concordia Women's Soccer in the history of the program.
